Sum of the  
lengths  
of two sides  
of a triangle

Statement:-

The sum of the lengths of any two sides of a triangle is greater than the third side.

When we add two sides of a triangle in this case AB & AC which is 4cm and 6cm. The sum of both sides will be greater than the third side which is AC = 3cm.



Pythagoras  
PROPERTY

In a right-angled triangle, the square on the hypotenuse = the sum of the squares on its sides.  
If a triangle is not right-angled, this property does not hold good. This property is useful to decide whether a given triangle is right-angled or not.

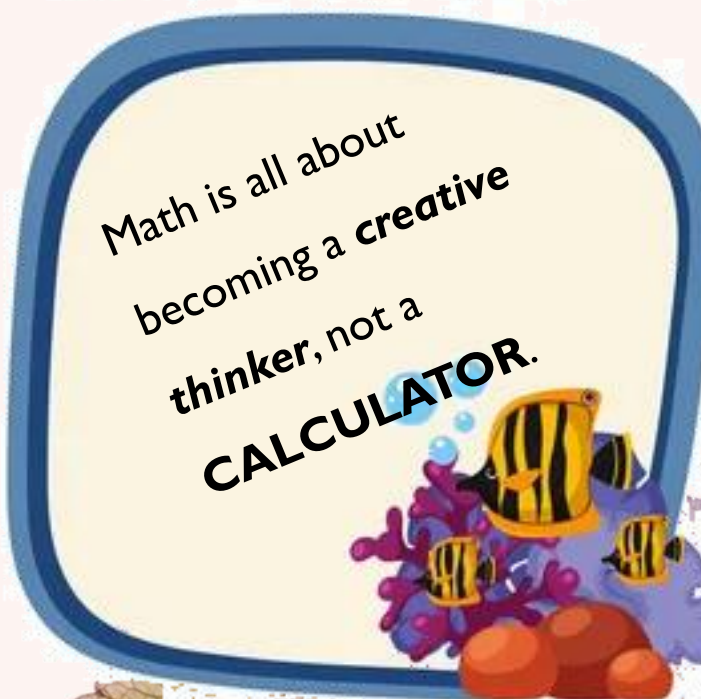
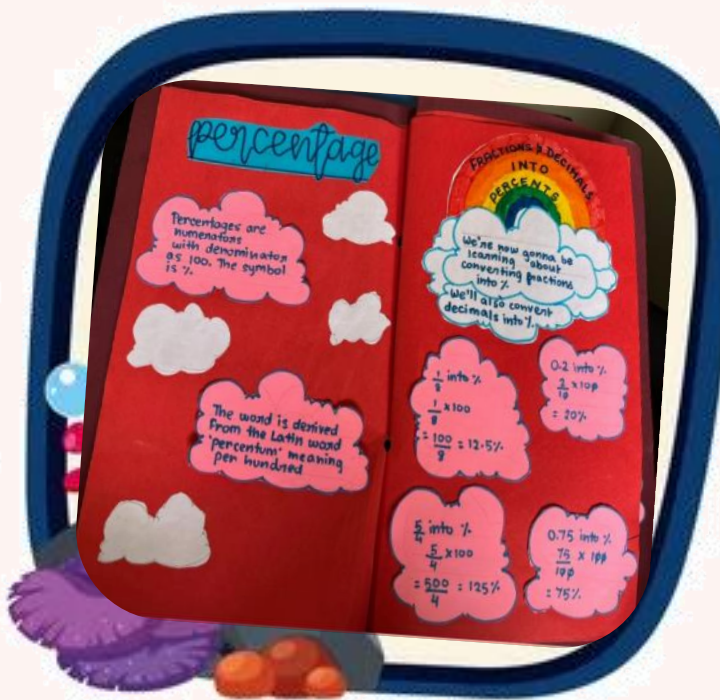
Pythagoras, a Greek philosopher, lived around 570 B.C. He was a mathematician and a philosopher. He discovered the property of right-angled triangles given in this section. The property is named after him to honor his contribution to mathematics. Many other mathematicians have also given an equivalent form of this property.

The side opposite to the right angle is called the hypotenuse. The other two sides are called the legs.
